- UNDERGARMENTS: Undergarments are not needed under a leotard. (For instances of necessity, please speak with the instructor. In these cases, undergarments should not be visible.)
- JEWELRY: For the safety of the students, jewelry should not be worn (stud earrings are okay).
- VIRTUAL LEARNING: In the event of Virtual Learning, students should abide by the studio's dress code as closely as possible to ensure safe & effective movement.
